TERMS AND CONDITIONS (see next page)

Your kind cooperation is requested in adhering to the following.

1. Dates are reserved only when \$500 deposit (non-refundable) is paid and contract is signed.
2. For each extra hour coverage, that is not mentioned at the time of signing contract, \$250 will be charged, to be paid on wedding day.
3. Exclusive Photographer. The Photographer shall be the exclusive photographer retained by the Client for the purpose of photographing the Client's wedding. Family and friends of the Client shall be permitted to photograph the wedding as long as they shall not interfere with the Photographer's duties.
4. Ownership / Usage. All photographic materials, including but not limited to negatives, transparencies, proofs, and previews, shall be the exclusive property of the Photographer. The Client may make reproductions of the Wedding photographs taken by the Photographer to be used for personal use but the Client may NOT sell the photographs or enter the photographs made by the Photographer in photographic contests or art exhibitions without written consent by the Photographer. If Client is obtaining a print for newspaper announcement of the wedding, Photographer authorizes Client to reproduce the print in this manner. In such event, Client shall request that the newspaper run a credit for the Photographer adjacent to the photograph, but shall have no liability if the newspaper refuses or omits to do so. If the Client desires use the photographs created by the Photographer for other uses, the Client shall NOT do so without first obtaining the written permission of the Photographer.
5. NOTICE OF COPYRIGHT: It is ILLEGAL to copy or reproduce these photographs elsewhere without Photographer's permission, and violators of this Federal Law will be subject to its civil and criminal penalties.
6. MODEL/EXHIBITION/RELEASE: PHOTOGRAPHER retains ownership of digital originals and the unrestricted right to copyright, use and publish images resulting from this assignment for commercial, promotion, competition or other purposes such as, but not limited to, print ads, brochures, websites, exhibits and other promotions without compensation or liability to the client.
7. RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES. It is understood by the parties that Photographer is an independent contractor with respect to the client, and not an employee of the client. Client will not provide fringe benefits, including health insurance benefits, paid vacation, or any other employee benefit, for the benefit of Photographer.
8. Photographer will use only good quality professional materials; however, Photographer does not guarantee that all colors will be reproduced with absolute accuracy in Photographer's images. Color permanency will depend on the lighting and storage of the photographs by Client, and while they will provide many years of rich color, no warranty by Photographer is implied.
9. In the event that Photographer is unable to provide Coverage, Photographer will make its best efforts to secure the services of an alternate qualified photographer, however the liability of Photographer in any event shall be limited to the refund of the deposits then paid.
10. All Package costs are as stated at the time of booking & will remain once booking is confirmed. Cancellation: In the event of cancellation, \$500 deposit is deductible only. Rescheduling is subject to a \$250 surcharge, provided date is available.
11. COVERAGE: It is the Client's responsibility to make sure that members of the party are on time & available when requested for a photograph. COOPERATION: The parties agree to cheerful cooperation and communication for the best possible result within the definition of this assignment. PHOTOGRAPHER is not responsible if key individuals fail to appear or cooperate during photography sessions or for missed images due to details not revealed to PHOTOGRAPHER. PHOTOGRAPHER recommends that CLIENT designate a "photo helper" to point out important individuals for formal or candid photographs.
12. Limitation of Liability: In the unlikely event that all of some of the photographs fail to materialize or there is total photographic failure due to reasons beyond Photographer's control, the liability of Photographer will be limited to the refund of all money paid. Neither party shall be liable for indirect or consequential losses. In any event, the limit of Photographer's liability shall not exceed the Package Price.
13. Standard touchups as converting images to black & white, sepia toning, selective coloring, spot tinting, minor blemishes & zits removed, wrinkles and face lines softened are included at no extra cost. Custom enhancements and retouching at clients request after viewing the proofs may incur \$50 charge for an hour.
14. Inherent Qualities. Client is aware that color dyes in photography may fade or discolor over time due to the inherent qualities of dyes, and Client releases Photographer from any liability for any claims whatsoever based upon fading or discoloration due to such inherent qualities. If flash photography is NOT allowed during the wedding ceremony (see Yes/NO checkboxes in contract above), the Client understands that high-speed film must be used creating a grainy effect in the photograph or low-speed film will be used with long shutter speeds that will create blurring effects in the photograph.
15. Photographer's Standard Price List. The charges in this Agreement are based on the Photographer's Standard Price List. This price list is adjusted periodically and future orders shall be charged at the prices in effect at the time when the order is placed.

16. SHOOTING TIME/OVERTIME RATES/ADDITIONS: CLIENT is responsible for added expenses due to conditions imposed by CLIENT but not revealed at contract inception; e.g., extensive photographic retouching of serious blemishes, other digital enhancements, travel expenses due to change of location or event overtime.
17. HOUSE RULES: The photographer is limited by the guidelines of ceremony official or reception site management. CLIENT agrees to accept the technical results of their imposition on the photographer. Negotiation with the officials for moderation of guidelines is CLIENT's responsibility; PHOTOGRAPHER will offer technical recommendations only.
18. COMPLETION SCHEDULE: Prints generally take about 4-6 weeks from time of print order to be processed and delivered to CLIENT. Albums can take 2-3 months to design and produce. CLIENT should place order with enough time to allow for normal delays.
19. PAYMENTS: CLIENT agrees to timely payment. In event of payment delay, CLIENT is responsible for (but not limited to) bad check fees, collection costs, certified mailing, lawyer's fees, and court costs.
20. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties, and there are no other promises or conditions in any other agreement whether oral or written.
21. APPLICABLE LAW. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of New Jersey.
